- WHY**
 - In San Francisco, 150,000 people struggle each day to feed themselves and their families. Hunger manifests itself as a consistent lack of enough food to meet nutritional requirements. It can mean fewer meals each day and poor-quality food that is calorie-rich but nutrient-poor. The Arriba Juntos food pantry is part of the San Francisco Food Bank's network of 193 neighborhood pantries that serve locals within the city limits.
 - Nationwide, the rising prices of food and gas are forcing working parents to make difficult decision between paying the bills and putting food on the table. Each year, **Feeding America** feeds more than **25 million Americans** who live without consistent access to adequate amounts of nutritious food, including **9 million children** and **3 million senior citizens**.
 - In just three years **ONEXONE** has raised over \$7 Million for its charitable partners, including H2O Africa, Yele Haiti, Millennium Promise, War Child, and Spread the Net. With its U.S. operations established, **ONEXONE** is committed to spending a portion of all funds raised on its American charitable partners including Feeding America.
